FINAL JUDGMENT

Upon petitioner's motion filed herein on July 25, 1966, for approval of a compromise settlement in accordance with a stipulation of the parties filed on the same date, which stipulation is hereby incorporated by reference into and made a part of this judgment; and the Commission having held a hearing on the proposed settlement in Washington, D. C. on July 26, 1966, with evidence both oral and written having been received and considered; and findings of fact and an interlocutory order having been made and entered in this matter on August 1, 1966, finding that the said compromise settlement is fair and just to all the parties and has been duly approved by the authorized representatives of petitioner and the authorized representative of the Secretary of the Interior, and that a final judgment in conformity with said stipulation be entered upon receipt of a certified copy of an order by the United States Court of Claims dismissing said appeal (App. No. 1-66) pending in that Court and remanding the case to the Commission; and it appearing that such an order dismissing said appeal has been filed herein, therefore, a final judgment should be entered in accordance with aforesaid stipulation and findings of fact,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the motion of the petitioner for final judgment pursuant to said stipulation filed herein be, and the same hereby is granted, and that accordingly judgment be, and is hereby entered in favor of the petitioner, the Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Reservation, Montana, against the defendant for said sum of \$4,431,622.18.
